

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below and to all others whom it may concern.

Application has been made to Hampshire County Council by Mrs Jennifer Larby of 13 Coles Mede, Winchester, SO21 2EG, under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 26th June 2015 by virtue of a significant number of the inhabitants of the locality having indulged in lawful sports and pastimes on the land as of right, for a period of at least twenty years, and continuing to do so.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration, may be inspected by prior appointment by contacting the Countryside Access Team – email row.notices@hants.gov.uk / telephone 0370 779 0202.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to the Countryside Access Team, Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UL, on or before **13 November 2020**. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.

Approximately 0.18 hectares of land, situated to the south and east of Coles Mede, in the parish of Otterbourne, in the City of Winchester, and known as 'The Green'.
